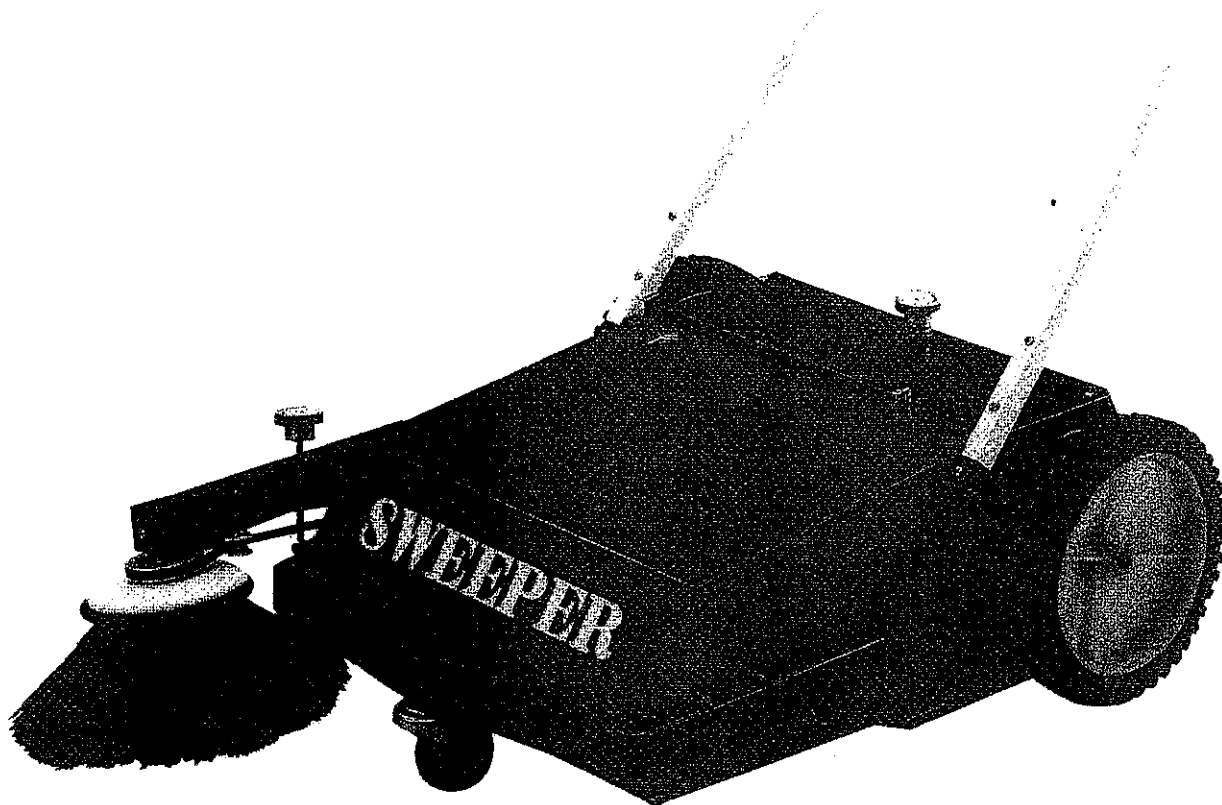


PUSH SWEEPER

MANY TIMES FASTER THAN CLEANING WITH A PUSH BROOM AND DOES A BETTER JOB TOO. BRUSH AND BROOM COVER 2000 M²/HOUR. AS EASY TO PUSH AS A CHILDREN'S CART. ROTATION OF WHEELS TURNS BROOMS CLEANS 27 INCH SWATH. SIDE BROOM ALLOWS FOR CLEANING ALONG CURBS OR WALLS IN CORNERS. NO ENGINE NOR MOTOR, NO NOISE, NO ODOR. REQUIRE NO MAINTENANCE. RESERVOIR CAN BE EMPTIED EASILY AND RAPIDLY.



ALL STEEL FRAME ACTS AS A BUMPER, RUBBER-TIRED WHEELS. DIFFERENTIAL MOUNTING ALLOWS SWEEPING EVEN IN CORNERS. REMOVABLE TANK IN SHEET STEEL TILT-MOUNTED ON 2 BEARINGS. SHEET STEEL BODY. ROLLER BRUSH COMPOSED OF 10 INDIVIDUALLY INTERCHANGEABLE POLYPROPYLENE BROOM HAIR ELEMENTS. SIDE BRUSH IN POLYPROPYLENE BROOM HAIR. CAN BE RAISED AND DISENGAGES AUTO-MATICALLY. FLOOR PRESSURE ADJUSTABLE BY KNURLED KNOBS.

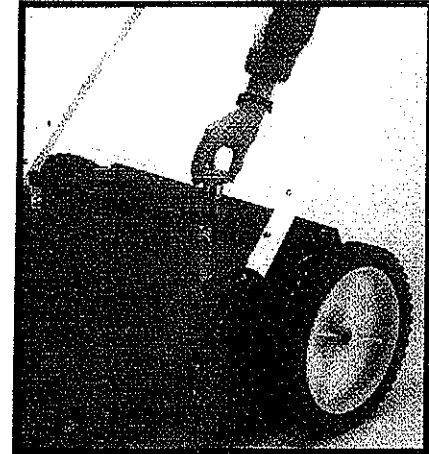
IT CAN BE USED ANYWHERE, ANYTIME...INDOORS OR OUTDOORS FOR CONCRETE, TILE N MANY COMMERCIAL CARPETS SUCH AS: GAS STATIONS, THEATERS, WAREHOUSES, INDUSTRIAL PLANTS, TENNIS COURTS, PARKING LOTS, SCHOOLS, OFFICES, HOSPITALS, STORES, SHOPPING MALLS, APARTMENT COMPLEXES, GARAGE N DRIVE WAY...ETC.

NOT USABLE FOR LIQUIDS OR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.

OPERATION

1. ADJUST THE HEIGHT OF THE MAIN SWEEPING BROOM SO THAT THE BRISTLES JUST TOUCH THE FLOOR.

NOTE: SWEEPING PERFORMANCE WILL BE POOR AND THE MACHINE WILL BE HARD TO PUSH IF THE MAIN BROOM IS SET TOO LOW.



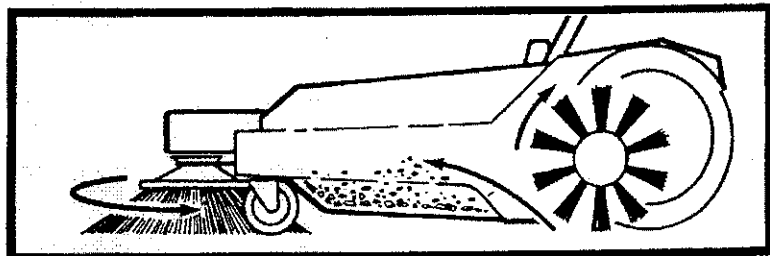
2. LOWER THE SIDE BROOM WHEN SWEEPING ALONG CURBS OR WALLS. LIFT THE SIDE BROOM WHEN SWEEPING IN AN OPEN AREA TO AVOID RAISING DUST.

NOTE: ADJUST THE SIDE BROOM HEIGHT SO THAT 1/3 OF THE BRISTLES ARE TOUCHING THE FLOOR.



3. PUSH THE MACHINE FORWARD AT A COMFORTABLE SPEED. THE MAIN BROOM KICKS DIRT AND DEBRIS INTO DIRT HOPPER.

NOTE: THE MACHINE DOES NOT SWEEP WHEN IT IS PULLED BACKWARD.



4. LIFT THE HOPPER OFF OF THE MACHINE AND EMPTY IT AFTER EACH USE, OR WHENEVER DEBRIS IS LEFT BEHIND THE MACHINE.

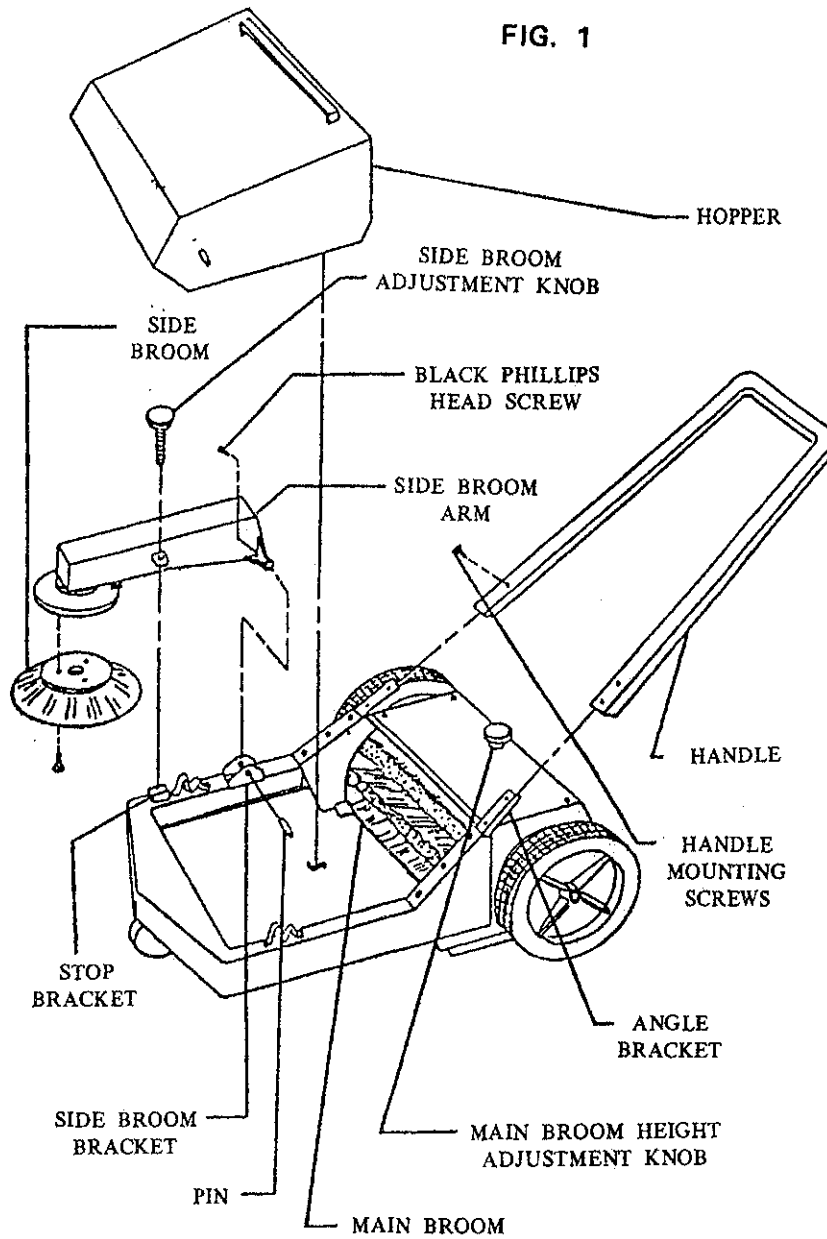
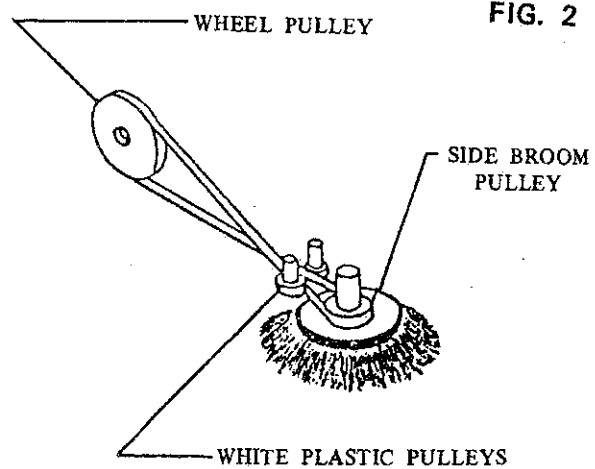

CAUTION

WHEN THE MACHINE IS DELIVERED, CAREFULLY INSPECT THE SHIPPING CARTON AND THE MACHINE FOR DAMAGE. IF DAMAGE IS EVIDENT, SAVE THE SHIPPING CARTON SO THAT IT CAN BE INSPECTED BY THE TRUCKING COMPANY THAT DELIVERED IT. CONTACT THE TRUCKING COMPANY IMMEDIATELY TO FILE A DAMAGE CLAIM. MAKE SURE THAT ALL LOOSE PARTS AND LITERATURE ARE REMOVED BEFORE THE SHIPPING CARTON IS DISCARDED.

ASSEMBLY

1. REMOVE THE (4) HANDLE MOUNTING SCREWS FROM THE ANGEL BRACKETS ON THE MACHINE.
2. SLIDE THE HANDLE OVER THE ANGLE BRACKETS. LINE UP THE HOLES IN THE HANDLE WITH THE HOLES IN THE ANGLE BRACKETS AND REINSTALL THE (4) SCREWS.
3. PULL THE HANDLE ON TOP OF THE HOPPER UPWARD AND LIFT THE HOPPER OFF OF THE MACHINE.
4. LOWER THE SIDE BROOM INTO THE SIDE BROOM BRACKET SO THAT THE HOLES IN THE BRACKET ARE LINED UP WITH THE HOLE IN THE ARM.
5. SLIDE THE PIN (FROM THE HARDWARE PACKAGE) THROUGH THE HOLES IN THE BRACKET AND INTO THE ARM. POSITION THE PIN SO THAT IT IS CENTERED ON THE BRACKET.
6. INSTALL THE BLACK PHILIPS HEAD SCREW IN THE SIDE BROOM ARE AS SHOWN IN FIG. 1. TIGHTEN THE SCREW TO HOLD THE PIN IN PLACE.
7. LIFT THE RIGHT, REAR WHEEL OFF OF THE GROUND AND PUT THE BELT AROUND THE PULLEY ON THE INSIDE OF THE WHEEL. PIVOT THE SIDE BROOM ARM ALL THE WAY UP.
8. PULL THE BELT TOWARDS THE FRONT OF THE MACHINE AND TWIST THE BELT $1/4$ TURN COUNTER-CLOCKWISE (THE PART OF THE BELT FROM THE TOP OF THE REAR WHEEL SHOULD MOVE AWAY FROM THE MACHINE).
9. LIFT THE BELT SO THAT IT IS OUTSIDE OF THE SIDE BRCOM ARM AND INSTALL IT AROUND THE SIDE BROOM PULLEY.
10. ROUTE THE BELT BETWEEN THE (2) WHITE PLASTIC PULLEYS. AS SHOWN IN FIG. 2.
11. INSTALL THE SIDE BROOM ON THE SIDE BROOM ARE USING THE (3) SCREWS AND THE (3) LOCKWASHERS FROM THE HARDWARE PACKAGE.
12. LOWER THE SIDE BROOM ARE AND POSITION THE BELT SO THAT IT RUNS THROUGH THE SIDE BROOM ARM.
13. SCREW THE SIDE BROOM ADJUSTMENT KNOB INTO THE SIDE BROOM ARM, AS SHOWN IN FIG. 1. ADJUST THE KNOW SO THAT ABOUT $1/3$ OF THE SIDE BROOM BRISTLES ARE TOUCHING THE FLOOR.
14. LOOSEN THE (2) SCREWS THAT HOLD THE SIDE BROOM BRACKET AGAINST THE CHASSIS. MAKE SURE THAT THE HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT SCREW IS BETWEEN THE EDGES OF THE STOP BRACKET ON THE FRAME. PULL THE SIDE BROOM FORWARD AS FAR AS THE BELT WILL ALLOW, AND TIGHTEN THE SCREWS.

MAINTENANCE

ONCE PER MONTH

1. TIP THE MACHINE ON ITS SIDE AND REMOVE ANY STRING THAT IS WRAPPED AROUND THE MAIN SWEEPING BROOM.
2. LUBRICATE THE FRONT CASTER WHEEL WITH LIGHT MACHINE OIL.
3. INSPECT THE RUBBER SKIRT ON THE HOPPER. REPLACE THE SKIRT IF IT IS TORN.

EVERY 6 MONTHS

1. INSPECT THE RUBBER SKIRTS ON EACH SIDE AND BEHIND THE SWEEPING BROOM. REPLACE THE SKIRT IF IT IS TORN.
2. TIP THE MACHINE ON ITS SIDE AND INSPECT THE MAIN BROOM FOR WEAR. REPLACE THE BROOM WHEN THE BRISTLES ARE WORN TO A LENGTH OF 1½ IN. (38 MM)

RENEWAL OF THE BROOM ASSEMBLIES

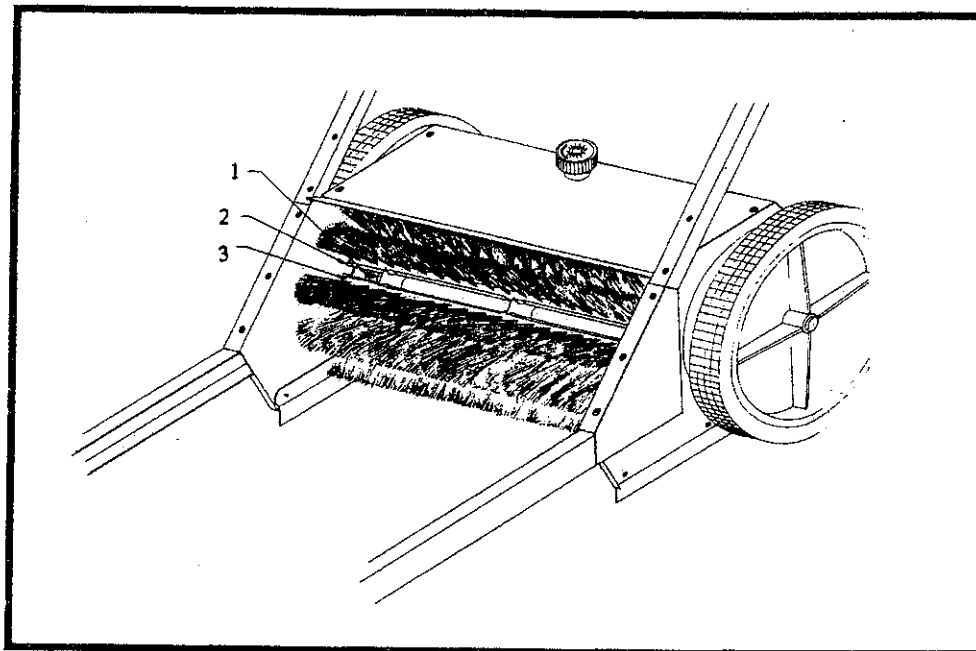
THE BROOM ROLLER CONSISTS OF A BROOM SHAFT WITH THREE BROOM SUPPORTS, ONE LOCK WASHER WITH HOLLOW SCREW AND 10 BROOM ASSEMBLIES, AS FOLLOWS:

5 BROOM ASSEMBLIES WITH BRISTLES OF 0.006 IN. (0.15 MM) -P/N 193488

5 BROOM ASSEMBLIES WITH BRISTLES OF 0.01 IN. (0.25 MM) -P/N 193489

THE BROOM ASSEMBLIES ARE REPLACED AS DESCRIBED BELOW

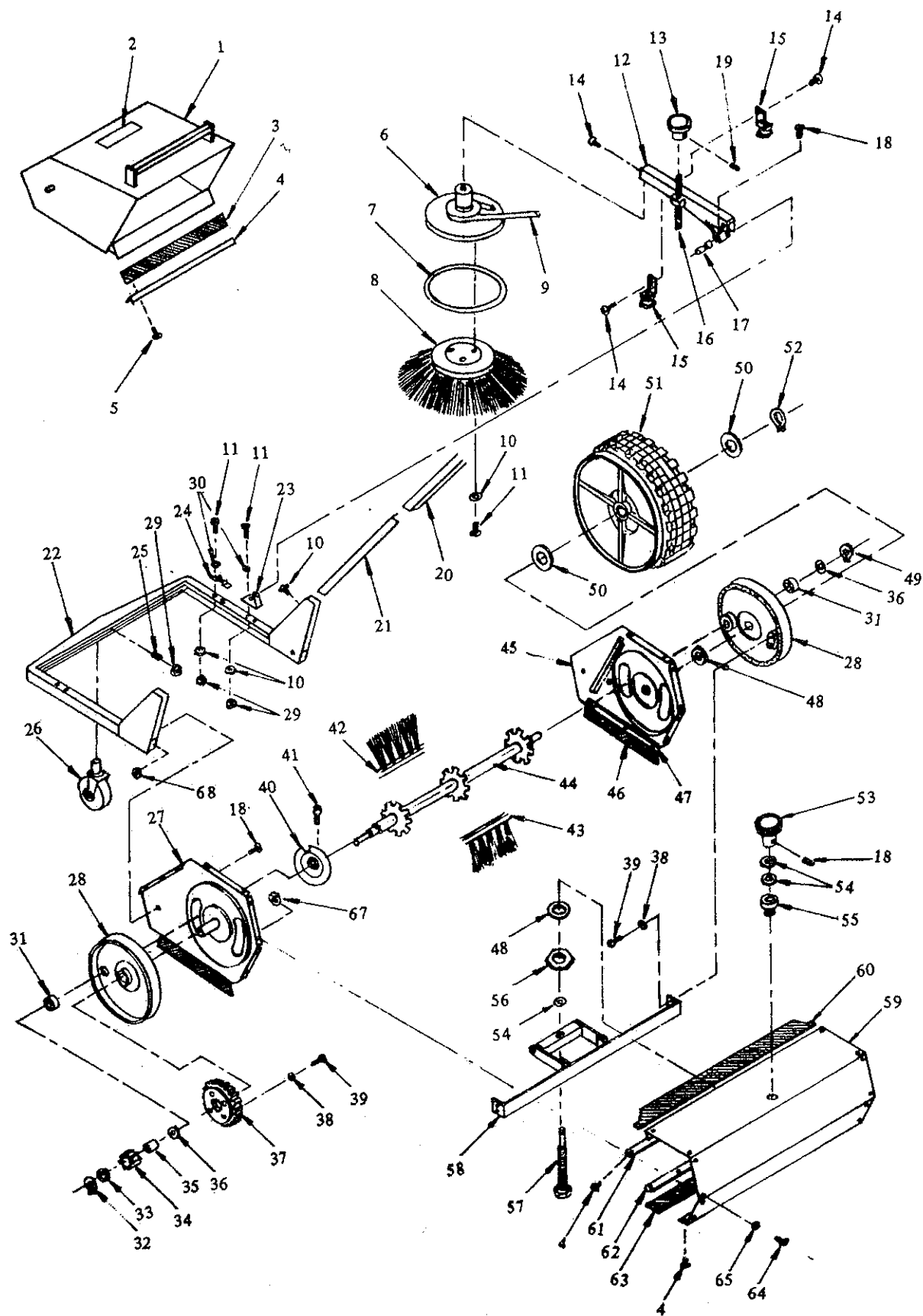
1. UNSCREW THE CAP SCREW (ALLEN KEY, 0.2 IN, -5 MM)
2. TURN LOCKWASHER SLIGHTLY, UNTIL THE NOTCH AND THE END OF THE BROOM ASSEMBLY ARE PLACED NEXT TO EACH OTHER.
3. PULL BROOM ASSEMBLY TO THE LEFT. (BROOM VIEWED FROM THE FRONT END, IN ORDER TO MAKE IT UNLOCK FROM THE BROOM SUPPORTS OF THE BROOM SHAFT AND TO REMOVE IT.
4. TURN ON THE LOCKWASHER AND REMOVE THE FOLLOWING BROOM ASSEMBLY AS DESCRIBED ABOVE.
5. INSERT NEW BROOM ASSEMBLIES WITH BRISTLES OF ALTERNATELY 0.006 IN. (0.15 MM) AND 0.01 IN. (0.25 MM) IN THE REVERSE FASHION.
